I. What Christ Can Do For You

- A. Christ can save you from sin (Mt 1:21)
 - 1. He can save one from the *guilt* of sin (Col 1:13-14)
 - 2. He can save one from the *condemnation* of sin (**Rom 8:1**)
 - 3. He can save one from the *control* of sin [Rom 8:1-2; made *free* from law (rule) of sin]
- B. Christ can give you abundant life (**Jn 10:10**)
- C. Christ can lead you to the Father (**Jn 14:6**)

II. What Christ Can Do In You

- A. He can inspire the heart with *hope* (Col 1:27)
 - 1. Hope anchors the soul in a sea of fear, turmoil, frustration, hate, and uncertainty (**Heb 6:19-20**)
 - 2. Hope gives one a *reason to rejoice* (Rom 5:2)
- B. He can *enable* one to face the problems of life (**Phil 4:13**)
 - 1. The Lord was Paul's hope and stay even when all others forsook him (2 Tim 4:16-17)
 - 2. The Lord will "stand by" us when we live for Him!
- C. He gives peace to the heart (Col 3:15)
- D. He *grants power* to help His people (**Eph 3:20**)
 - 1. Power to stand against temptation (Heb 4:15-16)
 - 2. Power to do good (**Eph 5:11-12**)

III. What Christ Can Do With You

- A. He can make a "Fisher of men" of you (Mt 4:19)
- B. He can make:
 - 1. **Better fathers and husbands** (*Eph 5:25; 6:1; Col 3:21*)
 - 2. **Better mothers and wives** (*Eph 5:23; Titus 2:2-6; Col 3:18*)
 - 3. Better sons and daughters (Eph 6:1-2; Col 3:20)

IV. Lessons for Us Today

- A. Benefits Only with Christ
 - 1. Only Christ offers the things we have discussed today.
 - 2. The things that mankind offers are only temporary in nature and they are not adequate for facing the trials of life.

- B. Only Christ makes us acceptable to God. (Col 1:19-22)
 - 1. When we compare what Christ offers and what man offers, Christ offers more.
 - 2. What Christ offers leads to a life that far exceeds this present life.

Application & Conclusion:

- 1. One must pay the price of being a Christian (Mt 16:24-26)
- 2. If you choose not to be a Christian the price is MUCH higher.
